Leopard is kept at Port Pendennis Marina, Falmouth, which is within short walking distance of Falmouth branch line rail stations. Door to deck collections can also be arranged.

Built for the Admiralty from Teak in 1959, Morgan Giles was commissioned to create 'the perfect yacht'. *Leopard* has the style and charm to stop sailors in their tracks and to admire and appreciate her sleek lines and graceful way she sails.

Carefully maintained and recently re-fitted we have combined the classic and the contemporary to offer charters onboard this timeless beauty with the best in modern navigational equipment, high quality, all-weather clothing and regularly serviced life jackets and safety equipment. *Leopard* is fully coded to all safety standards and comes with a highly qualified skipper (RYA Yachtmaster) and experienced crew - they are also excellent cooks and will provide you with a tasty and nutritious meal to compliment your day/s of sailing. At 43 feet in length, *Leopard* accommodates groups of up to seven on day trips and five on overnight journeys. The sleeping arrangement comprises of two single berths in the forward cabin, two single berths on the port (left) side and a single berth on the starboard (right) side. The final quarter berth is always occupied by the skipper.

Leopard has the benefit of full cooking facilities in the galley and seating is either in the saloon down below or the cockpit - perfect on a summers evening!
